- Conservation fund: \$245,666.54; Freese account: \$3385.28. A motion was made by Erick Berglund and seconded by Serita Frey to return the remaining funds in the Freese account to the conservation fund. The motion passed unanimously
- Erick Berglund made a motion (seconded by Serita Frey) to reimburse Lisa Wohlford for office supplies up to the amount of \$200.00. The motion passed unanimously.

Land Conservation

Regulated Wetlands

- Received correspondence from DES indicating the Howard and Carol Viens at 6 Sunset Lane (tax map/lot #207/52) have replaced/rebuilt retaining walls without a permit. They have 60 days to submit a Dredge and Fill application.

New Business

- Bear-Paw has proposed that their annual Biothon be held at the Freese property. DCC supports this activity, although concern was expressed regarding parking. Erick Berglund will contact Dan Kern to discuss the use of a shuttle.

- Deerfield was honored and received a plaque at the Bear-Paw annual meeting for the Freese conservation effort.
