

DEERFIELD PLANNING BOARD INVITES CITIZENS TO MASTER PLAN UPDATE MEETING

The Deerfield Planning Board has been working on the master plan update with the Southern NH Planning Commission. Input from community meetings and the town-wide survey in 2007 have been very important in guiding that work.

The Planning Board invites all citizens to join us at a public meeting at 7:00 to 9 p.m. on Wednesday, January 30, 2008 at the George B. White Building. At the meeting, the Board will discuss:

- An overview of the master plan process
- Draft plan goals and objectives
- The Vision Statement for Deerfield's future
- Maps and data about the type and location of possible future development ("build-out" scenarios)
- Future land use map for the master plan

The Planning Board is seeking public input at this point, because a great deal of work has already been done, and the Board would like to obtain feedback from Deerfield residents while that work is still in draft form.
