

Low & Moderate Tax Relief Program

The Low and Moderate Income Homeowner's Property Tax Relief Program runs annually between May 1st and June 30th.

The law allows 120 days (approximately 4 months) for processing from the date of receipt of your completed claim received by the Department between May 1st and June 30th.

Form DP-8: The 2007 DP-8 will be made available by the end April of 2008 for the May 1 to June 30, 2008 filing period.

An eligible claimant is a person who is:

- ⊗ Single with adjusted gross income equal to or less than \$20,000;
- ⊗ Married or head of NH household with adjusted gross income less than or equal to \$40,000; who must also:
- ⊗ Own a homestead subject to the State Education Property Tax; and have resided in that homestead on April 1, 2006.
