

**TOWN OF DEERFIELD
BOARD OF SELECTMEN/EMERGENCY MEETING
March 17, 2010
MINUTES**

Call to Order:

6:00PM Chairman of the Board of Selectmen, Stephen R. Barry called the Meeting to Order.

Roll Call:

Present: Stephen R. Barry, Chairman; R. Andrew Robertson, Vice Chairman;
Alan O'Neal, Selectman

Absent: John Reagan and Bill Perron Selectmen

Also Present: Cynthia Heon, Town Administrator

Chairman Barry noted that Selectman Reagan may not be able to attend as the House is in Session and expected to go later into the evening.

6:01pm Chairman Barry stated he was recessing the Meeting until Selectman Perron arrived.

6:06pm Selectman William Perron arrived.

Chairman Barry reconvened the Selectmen's Meeting.

Chairman Barry explained the Board would need to enter a Nonpublic Session to discuss a personnel issue which has arisen and the discussion could not be done in a public session.

Nonpublic Session:

6:07pm Vice Chairman R. Andrew Robertson made a motion to enter the Nonpublic Session under RSA 91-A:3,II(a) the dismissal, promotion, or compensation of any public employee or the disciplining of such employee, or the investigation of any charges against him or her, unless the employee affected (1) has a right to a meeting and (2) request that the meeting be open, in which case the request shall be granted and under RSA 91-A:3,II(c) matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of the public body itself, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine, or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant. Seconded by Selectman Alan O'Neal.

Roll Call Vote: Perron-Yes; O'Neal-Yes; Robertson-Yes; Barry-Yes

6:22pm The Nonpublic Session ended.

No Action/No Decisions:

Selectman O'Neal stated that no action was taken or decisions made within the Nonpublic Session.

Minutes Sealed:

MOTION: Selectman Alan O'Neal made a motion the minutes of this Nonpublic Session be sealed as divulgence of information contained in those minutes would likely adversely affect the reputation of a person or persons not a member of this Board. Seconded by Vice Chairman R. Andrew Robertson.

Roll Call Vote: Perron-Yes; O'Neal-Yes; Robertson-Yes; Barry-Yes

MOTION: Vice Chairman Robertson made a motion to inform Transfer Station employees Lenny Mandigo and Kyle Mandigo, in writing, they will be placed on unpaid Administrative Leave for an indefinite period of time until the investigation into allegations against them has been completed and that they are not to enter the Transfer Station without being accompanied by a Police Officer. Seconded by Selectman Alan O'Neal.

VOTE: Chairman Barry called for the Vote. It was a Unanimous Vote in Favor.
