MINUTES**

**Call to Order:**

**5:30pm** Chairman of the Board, Stephen R. Barry called the Meeting to Order.

**Roll Call:**

**Present:** Stephen R. Barry, Chairman; Alan E. O'Neal, Vice Chairman; R. Andrew Robertson, John Reagan and William A. Perron, Selectmen

**Also Present:** Cynthia Heon, Town Administrator

**Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag:**

Chairman Barry asked everyone to rise for the pledge of allegiance to the Flag.

**Citizen's Comments:**

Chairman Barry recognized Charles Garland who asked if the Board was taking up the subject of purchasing tasers this evening. Mr. Garland was advised that discussion was scheduled for next week.

**Accounts Payable Manifest/\$16,063.81**

**MOTION:** Selectman R. Andrew Robertson made a motion to approve the Accounts Payable Manifest in the amount of \$16,063.81. Seconded by Selectman John Reagan.

**VOTE:** Chairman Barry called for the Vote. It was a Unanimous Vote in Favor.

**Signatures:**

1. Lakes Region Public Access (LRPA)/Municipal Public Access Agreement (2010 to 2011)

**MOTION:** Selectman Alan O'Neal made a motion the Board signs the agreement with Lakes Region Public Access Television. Seconded by Selectman R. Andrew Robertson.

**Discussion:** Steve Jamele, IT Administrator, submitted a review of the document which the Selectmen discussed. Selectman Reagan opposed signing the agreement. It was noted audio/ video equipment would be required if Deerfield was to broadcast live. If nothing was being broadcast, residents tuning in would see a blank channel.

Selectman Reagan's preference was to have Steve Jamele bring about live broadcasts in the Town of Deerfield and have a meeting schedule scroll across the screen as well. Selectman O'Neal mentioned having something similar to a power point show but money would have to be budgeted next year for equipment or, if possible, encumbered from 2010 funds.

**VOTE:** Chairman Barry called for the Vote. It was a Vote in Favor Yes-3 No-2

It was the consensus of the Board that Steve Jamele put together a presentation as to how this problem is going to be resolved and outline all the costs associated with the project.

2. Delegation of Deposit Authority

Lorena Sinnamon, Town Treasurer, asked that the Selectmen approve her recommendation that, as provided for under the law, authority be given to the Town Clerk/Tax Collector and the Deputy Town Clerk/Tax Collector to make deposits. The Board signed the document.

**MOTION:** Vice Chairman Alan O'Neal made motion the Board change Mrs. Heon's employment status from full time to on-call allowing her to carry out duties as Interim Town Administrator, at an hourly rate of \$30.25. Seconded by Selectman John Reagan.

**VOTE:** Chairman Barry called for the Vote. It was a Unanimous Vote in Favor.
