Tournament is Double elimination in both divisions. All games played at Deerfield Community School.

Grades 3-4 Division rules

- 1.) Final Roster of 8 to 15 players and maximum of three coaches must be submitted before first game
- 2.) Games will consist of two twelve minute halves stop time.
- 3.) Full court pressure is only allowed in last three minutes of each half, and never when a team leads by ten points or more
- 4.) Three full time outs per game
- 5.) Half time will be a maximum of three minutes long and may be shorter based on time available.
- 6.) Bonus on seventh team foul and double bonus on tenth team foul
- 7.) All unsportsmanlike technical player fouls will result in two foul shots, possession of the ball, a personal foul and a team foul. If technical is on coach the same applies minus the personal and team foul.
- 8.) All other NHFS rules apply

Grades 5-6 Division

- 1.) Final Roster of 8-15 15 players and maximum of three coaches must be submitted before first game.
- 2.) Games will consist of two fourteen minute halves stop time.
- 3.) No defensive restrictions other than a team may not use full-court pressure if leading by fifteen or more.
- 4.) Three full time outs per game.
- 5.) Half time will be a maximum of three minutes long and may be shorter based on time available
- 6.) Bonus on seventh team foul and double bonus on tenth team foul.
- 7.) All unsportsmanlike technical player fouls will result in two foul shots, possession of the ball, a personal foul, and a team foul. If technical is on coach the same applies minus the personal and team foul.
- 8.) All other NHFS rules apply

Daily admission charge of **three dollars per day** for adults and \$1 for students of all grades will be charged to all non-rostered children and adults. Concession stand will be available.

Any cars parked in designated no parking areas may be towed or ticketed at vehicle owners expense

Any unsportsmanlike conduct from players, coaches and fans may result in expulsion from the tournament without refund.

Directions to Deerfield Community School:

FROM **SEACOAST 101 WEST** take exit 3 on Route 27/43 bear left onto 27, straight thru light and to Deerfield (passing the fairgrounds on right) to Junction of 107 take left and follow thru town to Deerfield, Community School on left.

FROM **NORTHWOOD ROUTE 4** AT JUNCTION OF 202/9 in Northwood. Take route 43 to Deerfield, left at 107 junction (Mr. Mikes on your right), Deerfield Community School on right about 1 mile.

FROM **ROUTE 4 CONCORD** follow route 4 to Epsom circle thru to junction of 107 take right follow to Deerfield. After Mr. Mikes on left Deerfield Community School is about 1 mile on right.
