The job of the school board is NOT to run the school, but to make sure it is run well.

The presentation ended with a Q & A by board members with Mr. Christina.

Nancy Shute was thrilled to account for the missing students at CHS from DCS. For the future, we need a way to track students going to different high schools.

Erroll Rhodes encouraged the board to send any student accomplishments/achievements to the Backyard Gazzette by November 15th.
